Sit Stay & Play training add

on for daycare

We are excited to announce a new service we will be providing called Sit Stay & Play. Sit Stay & Play is a one on one positive reinforcement training session that can be added onto daycare when your dog is at daycare. For an additional \$50 your dog will be sent home with a video of what commands they worked on along with homework and how to work on the behavior at home. Right now the program will be offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays. If your dog comes on another day and you are interested in the service we can add or switch days. If you are interested in signing up please respond to this message.

What is the importance of training and exercise?

Just like humans, dogs need to exercise their brain and their body. There are many benefits to positive reinforcement training including teaching your dog new skills, altering undesired behavior and setting expectations between you and your dog. While your dog is getting mental stimulation along with physical exercise they will be a happy and tired pup. With training, you will strengthen the communication between you and your dog and they will be able to exercise out any pent up energy.

Who will be training my dog?

This positive reinforcement training program was designed by Julie Cardoza with the goal to give dogs mental stimulation along with physical exercise. While allowing the owners and dogs develop a closer bond. The program is a great way for dogs and humans to communicate with each other. Our trainers have gone through an extensive training course with Julie prior to training your dog and also have a background with positive reinforcement training.

How does this program work?

We conduct our positive reinforcement training with clicker training. The clicker makes a clicking sound and we follow the sound by giving the dog a treat whenever the dog does the command we are looking for. By using the clicker the dog is able to pinpoint what behavior we are looking for and is able to learn the behavior quicker. When they hear the click and receive a treat then they know what they did at that moment was correct and will continue to do learn the command with practice. Since all of our voices have different tones, "yes" or "good" can confuse a dog when learning new commands. The clicker is a consistent sound that the dogs easily understand. There are 4 different training levels that are listed below. On the first day we will evaluate your dog's understanding of commands and see where they fit on the sit stay play level. On the second day we will begin training in the appropriate knowledge level. After each training session we will make a video of what we worked on with your dog and send it right to you. We will also send your dog home with homework to work on at home with them. It is very important to work on the same commands at home that we are working on at school. We recommend a minimum of 2 days a week for training. If you have anything specifically you would like us to work on you can request it.

Weddings

Do you want your fur child to be a ring bearer or flower girl in your wedding? We know how special your wedding day is. We want to make the day easy for you and your fur child. There is no need to worry, your fur child will be wagging their tail spending that special moment with you.

Service includes:
